

Electronic payment service fees

During the past few years, St. Albert Public Schools has been responsive to requests and has implemented various improvements to streamline and simplify the way student fees are paid. This includes moving most payments online. This added convenience has increased efficiency for the users and the district, but it also has resulted in additional banking and software service charges. As such, effective September 1, 2017, all debit and credit card payments made online will be charged a service fee of 2.4%. Debit and credit card payments made in-person on Moneris terminals will be charged a fee of 3.0%. Moneris terminals are currently used at the high schools. Moneris terminals are also used at district office for bus pass purchases.
